Application instructions

To prevent damages to this camera or any products connected to it, this product can only be used within the specified range:

- 1. Do not expose the camera to rain or moisture.
- 2. This product contains no parts which can be maintained by users themselves. Any damage caused by dismantling the product by user without permission is not covered by warranty.
- 3. To prevent an electric shock, do not disassemble the camera; only qualified technicians can perform installation and maintenance.
- 4. Do not use under conditions that exceed the limited temperature, humidity or power supply specifications.
- 5. When cleaning the camera lens, please wipe it with a dry soft cloth. When the product is heavily soiled, please wipe it gently with a neutral detergent. Do not use strong or corrosive cleaning agents to avoid scratching the lens and affecting the image quality.

Electric safety

This product must be installed in strict compliance with local electrical safety standards.

Transport caution

Avoid heavy pressure, severe vibration, soaking damage to the product in transportation, storage, and installation.

Careful installation

- 1. The camera body is made of organic material, please do keep away from corrosive liquid, gas, or solid material.
- 2. Do not rotate the camera head violently, otherwise it may cause mechanical failure;
- 3. This product should be placed on a stable desktop or other horizontal surface. Do install the product obliquely, otherwise it may display inclined image.
- 4. Ensure there are no obstacles within rotation range of the holder.
- 5. Do not power on before completing installation.

Do not disassemble discretionarily


Open the sales package and check the contents. If any item is missing or damaged, please contact your dealer immediately.




1. Status light


Lights up blue when camera is on.

Install camera




1. Connect your camera to the USB-C port on the top of the display.



2. Secure the camera with the provided screws.


Use the privacy cover

Slide the privacy cover switch to the right to cover the lens.




Enhance your video conferencing experience with **Camera framing**

In **BenQ Camera** app, select **Menu > Settings > Camera framing**. The camera has three framing modes as below:

Descriptions

You can manually adjust the pan, tilt, zoom of the camera.



Manual PTZ

- 1. Tap +/- to zoom in and out.
- 2. Tap direction keys to pan or tilt. Select **Reset** to restore original framing.

	The camera will automatically track the position of all participants.
Face tracking	For access to this camera framing mode as the default setting, update your firmware to the latest version. See Update firmware on page 7 for details.
Voice tracking	The camera will track the position of all participants and automatically focus on the person speaking. See Enable Voice tracking in your conferencing apps on page 6 for details.


Enable Voice tracking in your conferencing apps

After properly installed on BenQ Board, the camera automatically enables **Face tracking** when you open a conferencing application. If you'd like the camera framing to automatically focus on the person who is speaking, follow the steps below to enable **Voice tracking**.

- 1. Open **BenQ Camera** app in your app list.
- 2. Select Menu 😑 > Settings 😂 .



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3. Under Camera framing, select Voice tracking. The changes will be applied directly.




Now when you start your video meeting, the camera will automatically adjust its view to focus on the speaker.

Update firmware




2. Under **BenQ Apps** , select **BenQ Camera** by to download the firmware.



3. In BenQ Board's app list 吕 , open BenQ Camera




4. Go to Menu = > Device info 💿 > Version. Tap Update to start the update.

- 6. You can check your firmware version in **Device info** (as in step 4).



Maintenance

Clean the lens whenever you notice dirt or dust on the surface.

- 1. Use soft cloth or tissue to clean the camera cover.
- 2. Use soft cloth to clean the lens; use neuter cleanser if smeared. Do NOT use strong or corrosive cleanser that may scuff the lens and affect the image.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
No video output & no image	 Try methods below: Make sure the USB port is normal and the power indication light is on. Disconnect the camera with computer and re-connect the USB cable. Check if the video software has selected the right device.
