Precaution


Please observe the following precautions.

- Power off all devices before installation.
- Remove the rubber feet from the bottom of the chassis, if any.
- Dissipate static electricity before installation. Failure to observe this precaution may result in ESD (electrostatic discharge) damage.
- Follow the installation guides below.
- The appropriate screw tightening torque is M3: 0.59 N·m (6.1 kgf·cm, approx.).
- Secure devices tightly in place.
- Do not block vent holes or cooling fans.

FP-Z30: For thin-profile, half rack devices


■ Installation

1. For devices originally having screws, remove the screws from their locations as illustrated below:




[Fig. 1] Removing screws


2. Attach the FP-Z30 mounting brackets to the chassis using the four (4) supplied M3 screws as shown below:



Mounting downward direction



 Mounting upward direction (Under-furniture mounting)




Note:

For some devices, mounting direction is not flexible.


[Fig. 2] Attaching FP-Z30 brackets

3. Mount the chassis to furniture using appropriate customer supplied screws.



[Fig. 3] Mounting chassis



Values "A" and "B" vary depending on products; refer to the appearance diagram.




[Fig. 5] FP-Z30 reference dimensions

FP-100 and FP-140: For quarter rack size devices


■ Installation

- 1. Attach the FP-100/FP-140 mounting plate to the bottom surface of the chassis using two (2) supplied M3 screws.
- 2. Mount and secure the chassis to furniture using appropriate customer supplied screws. You can also secure the chassis by securing it with zip-ties through the six (6) square holes (0.2 in. (6 mm)).
